DEADLINES FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS

Students should complete the athletic scholarship during early registration. Students who submit completed applications and the required attachments after the published deadline, will be denied. Deadline for submitting scholarship applications is one week prior to the registration deadline.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

University of Fort Lauderdale offers financial assistance through scholarships and the university's athletic scholarship fund. Any monies awarded are applied to tuition and fees **only**.

1. Scholarship/award disbursements listed below are null and void if not returned within 15 days of date issued.

2. My signature on this document certifies that I intend to participate in the sport(s) designated below.

3. I understand that I may lose the benefits and/or athletic portion of this scholarship if I:

- Do not satisfy the requirements for admission, eligibility, practice, and competition.
- Render myself ineligible.
- Do not maintain a minimum of 12 semester hours for each semester of enrollment unless I am in the last semester before graduation and am taking all the remaining required courses for my degree in which case my scholarship will be prorated in accordance to the policies of the University of Fort Lauderdale.
- Fraudulently misrepresent any information on the UFTL admissions application, academic transcripts, ACT/SAT scores or this form.
- Engage in misconduct and/or violation of the standards and rules of the University and its athletic program set forth in the college catalog, student handbook and the student athlete code of conduct. Or player agreement forms engage in misconduct and/or violation of the standards and rules of the NCCAA.
- Voluntarily withdraw from participation in the sport(s) program.
- Fail to meet university and/or NCCAA satisfactory progress guidelines.

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4. Participating in SPORT: The head coach reserves the right to dismiss me from the team or reduce my Scholarship for lack of effort and/or poor attitude.
5. All monetary values of this scholarship or institutional award shall be applied to my University of Fort Lauderdale UFTL Business Office account. There will be no monetary payments to the student. Scholarships will only be applied to the student's accounts after all available financial aid, except for loans, have been applied first.
6. I fully understand that this scholarship or institutional award can be rendered null and void if I fail to meet the eligibility and/or medical requirements of the university.
7. If all the above criteria are met, this athletic scholarship will be valid for one academic year. At the end of each season, athletic scholarships are reviewed and may be renewed by the head coach in conjunction with the Athletic Director based on athletic performance, academics and meeting all the above criteria and meeting regulations prescribed by the (NCAA). The renewal of this scholarship is not guaranteed at the end of the 2020-2021 academic year.
8. Depending on the amount of the award letter the student-athlete may take no less than 24 credit hours but can take a maximum of no more than 30 credit hours in Fall, Spring, and no more than 12 credits in the Summer, depending of the coach's approval.
9. When "ESL courses" are required, it will extend the number of credits needed and the graduation date will change; thus, affecting the number of years a student-athlete takes to graduate. Athletes only have a total of 4 years of eligibility in each sport to play. But it may take an athlete that had ESL work longer than 4 years to graduate. So in his/her 5th year of classes you may not be playing any longer if you have used up your 4 years of eligibility.
10. When a student – athlete is released from the athletic program and sport they are participating in at the University of Fort Lauderdale, their scholarship is terminated immediately. The Student – Athlete will also be responsible for any Fee's or Balance after termination from there athletic scholarship. It is also the right and discretion of the University to leave a student – athlete on their scholarship after they have been terminated from the program of the sport they participated in during their time at the University of Fort Lauderdale and Athletics.
11. Upon signing this agreement, all Student-Athletes are required to have a valid copy of a Medical Insurance Card and a completed physical exam, on file before any participation in sport activities.
12. When a Student – Athlete is released from the athletic team he/she is participating on; he/she would be dropped from their scholarship after the semester is finished.
13. The Student-Athlete is responsible to pay all monthly tuition payments on time, within the first 5 days of the month. If balances are not paid in time, their scholarship will be annulled.
14. University of Fort Lauderdale does not offer Room & Board. All athletes are responsible for their own housing and food during their time at UFTL.
15. The Student-Athlete is responsible to pay all his/hers housing rent, utilities and fees.
16. The Student-Athlete must have their own active individual medical insurance throughout the whole school year. If they do not possess insurance, the scholarship will be annulled.
